Curricular Areas: [Numeracy/ Literacy Overview]

In Maths we will be continuing to develop our mental strategies and written skills when solving addition and subtraction problems.

We will be investigating how to use different combinations of coins and notes to pay for goods. We will also be exploring simple 2D and 3D shapes and explaining their features. We will be learning to use the different shapes and fit them together to create a tiling pattern.

During writing and technology sessions this term we will be focusing on fact files. We will continue to practise using capital letters and full stops in our writing. Each week we will continue to learn a new sound and practise spelling our common words correctly. We will develop strategies to help spell and read tricky words.

Reading books will be read in class and also sent home to reinforce the learning.

At this time of year we will be having regular outdoor sessions, so please send your child to school with a suitable, warm jacket and footwear.
