Space

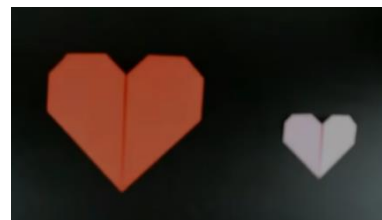
Create and describe your own planet. What does it look like? Who lives there? What is it made of? What is it called?
