Curricular Areas

Maths: This term we will develop our understanding of measurement, data handling, fractions and begin the concept of multiplication. P1/2L will engage in hands-on, practical activities to enhance their learning.

P1: Will continue to develop their knowledge of teen numbers and subtraction to 10.

P2: Will continue to develop strategies to support them with addition and subtraction within 20.

Literacy: P1 will continue to learn a new phoneme and new common words weekly. P1s will further develop skills and understanding in creating simple sentences. P2 will consolidate all sounds taught so far and have a focus on common words. This term we will focus on functional writing and developing our understanding of instructional vocabulary. This will be linked closely with the children's experiences within school, such as the steps required to plant vegetables in our school garden. We will continue to explore both non-fiction and fiction books while expanding our understanding through comprehension.

Health and Wellbeing: This term we will be exploring and developing our skills in tennis and skipping. We will also complete our Daily Mile regularly, and participate in a whole school competition to encourage fitness.

Interdisciplinary Learning: This term we will start our topic on 'Living and Growing'. During this topic we will explore privacy, how to look after our bodies and simple labelling of body parts. We will also look at how to care for growing things. In Art, our focus is on famous artists and their techniques. We will also have a block on animation, learning
