Curricular Areas

Numeracy

This term, our Numeracy focus will be on division, fractions, data-handling and position and movement. Pupils will continue to participate in a range of daily challenges, active group tasks, games on the iPads and problem-solving activities to develop their Mental Maths skills.

Literacy

When writing stories, P3.4A will continue to explore how to create their own exciting story openers. This term they will develop their understanding of how to use speech marks. P3.4A will continue to take part in Free Writing Friday sessions. The children will also continue to develop strategies to help spell and read common and tricky words.

Health and Wellbeing
