Curricular Areas

Numeracy: This term, we will begin by completing our Data Handling topic which we started before the holidays. We will then move on to develop our knowledge of Time. This will involve lots of practical work including calculating durations of time and using timetables to plan journeys.

Literacy: This term, we will be reading the novel Kaspar by Michael Morpurgo. This will allow us to further develop our knowledge of the Six Reading Strategies and how we can apply them to what we read. We will also continue to enjoy having weekly visits to our new library.

Writing this term will be related to our topic which will be a country comparison study. This will involve writing both Functional and Imaginative pieces including fact files, tourist brochures and diary entries.

Health and Wellbeing: This term, we will be focusing on Living and Growing. We will be learning about the changes that take place during puberty and how this impacts on our feelings and behaviour.
