Curricular Areas

Numeracy:

This term we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of division with remainders and decimals. We will also be extending our knowledge of measurement to include area and volume as well as the relationship between Time, Speed and Distance. This will lead to us revisiting Time as a topic looking particularly at calculating the duration between different periods of time.

Literacy:

We will continue to build on the children's knowledge of punctuation and grammar by using Big Writing strategies and will continue to embed Active Reading strategies through group reading sessions. We will be completing our Class Novel work this term and move on to reading a selection of different types of texts, including non-fiction. During Writing activities, we will be extending our use of vocabulary when creating different forms of text. We will be looking at scriptwriting, advertising and reviews relating to our P7 show. Throughout the term, we will be focusing on our presentation skills with individual talks on our Personal projects relating to different conflicts around the world.

Health and Wellbeing:

In PE this term we will be developing our tennis and racquet skills. Throughout the term we will also be exploring and developing our understanding of our body and how to keep safe during Living and Growing lessons.

Interdisciplinary Learning:
