Curricular Areas

Numeracy:

This term we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of division with remainders and decimals. This will lead on to extending our knowledge of fractions, percentages and decimals and how to relate this to real life experiences. In Maths, we will be developing our skills in reading and calculating time by learning how to effectively use timetables and plan events or journeys. We will also be investigating how to effectively collect, display and analyse data.

Literacy:

We will continue to build on the children's knowledge of punctuation and grammar by using Big Writing strategies and will continue to embed Active Reading strategies through group reading sessions. We will be reading a selection of fiction books this term. During Writing activities, we will be extending our use of vocabulary and use of different sentence openers when creating different forms of text. We will look at recount by creating newspaper reports and reviews. We will be finishing the term by creating a biography and even our own autobiography that we are sure the pupils will want to share with you. Throughout the term, we will be focusing on our presentation skills with group and individual talks.

Health and Wellbeing:

In PE this term, lessons will focus on gymnastics and athletics. We will build our reactions, skills, and accuracy. Throughout the term we will also be exploring and developing our understanding of our body and how to keep safe during Living and Growing.

Interdisciplinary Learning:

We have two main focuses this term. One being our upcoming show, Peter Pan, which I am sure you will all be looking forward to seeing after all the practice that is taking place at home. Also, we will be focusing on 'Our World of Work', where the pupils will be thinking about what they enjoy, the skills they have and what kind of career they would perhaps like in the future. We will be exploring a range of different careers and thinking about how they could achieve these.
