Starting School - Term 1 2023



Day 1 - Tuesday the 22nd August

- Children start school at <u>9:15am (unless otherwise arranged)</u>.
- The bell will ring two minutes before for children to line up.
- P1 and P1/2 children will line up with their new class in the playground near the front gate. Signs will mark where children line up on the first day. Children attending Enhanced Provision line up at the main front door.
- Children finish school at **12:10pm (unless otherwise arranged).**
- They will leave by the same door they came in.

Starting School - Term 1 2023



Day 2 – Wednesday 23rd August

- * Children start school at **<u>9:00am.</u>**
- * Children finish school at **12:15pm.**

They will continue to attend at these times until <u>Friday 1st</u> <u>September.</u>

- From Monday 4th September children will attend full time from <u>9:00am to 3:20pm.</u>
- Those children requiring an enhanced transition will have an agreed plan of times put in place.

School Day



- <u>Start</u> 9:00am
- <u>Playtime</u> 10:30 10:50am (healthy snack, no nuts please)
- <u>Lunch</u> 12:15 12:55pm
- <u>Playtime</u> 2:00 2:20pm
- <u>Home</u> 3:20pm

• Snack is optional. Water only in water bottles, no juice.





- Your child will have opportunities to play in or visit the playground and will be familiar with the area.
- All *new to P1* children will wear high-visibility vests for the first term so that playground staff can easily identify them.
- Please ensure that your child has suitable clothing to wear due to the unpredictable nature of Scottish weather.

<u>Lunchtime</u>



- A menu is available on Aberdeenshire Council website. <u>Primary school meals - Aberdeenshire Council</u>
- Meals are free for children in P1-5.
- (*If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please do still make the application to receive this as Portlethen PS receives Scottish Government Pupil Equity Funding for each child who is entitled to this). Free school meals Aberdeenshire Council
- Three choices per day, child indicates choice in the morning.
- You can supply a packed lunch for your child.
- *Please note that if a packed lunch is brought in from home then your child cannot choose a meal from school on the same day. The meal chosen in class in the morning, is the meal that will be prepared for your child.
- ★ Special diets can be catered for.

Try a School Lunch



- On Thursday 31st August children will have the opportunity to try a school lunch. This will be free.
- One adult can also accompany at an approximate cost of £2.80.
- Lunch will start at 11.40am so please arrive at 11.35am. If children are not having school lunch then they will need to be collected at 11:30am.

Communication from the school




- Class termly newsletter and a whole school monthly newsletter.

- Please complete the medical form if your child requires medication in school, for example the use of an inhaler.


There will be further opportunities for you to interact with the school throughout the year.
