Curricular Areas

Numeracy:

This term we will be continuing with addition and subtraction using multiples of 10/100. We will be exploring different coins and their value and how to use these to pay for different amounts as part of our Enterprise work. We will also continue to explore 2D and 3D shapes, focusing on shape symmetry.

Literacy:

The children will continue to take part in phonics/spelling, listening, talking, reading, handwriting and writing lessons. We will focus on introducing and including speech, exclamation and question marks as well as continuing to enhance our writing with different sentence openers and connectives.

Health and Wellbeing:

During PE lessons we will be continuing to take part in co-operative games and activities to enhance our fitness. We will also be taking part in the Daily Mile and Loose Parts. We will be developing our awareness of hygiene when making food products for the Christmas Fayre.
