#### Curricular Areas

**Numeracy:** We will be working with money this term. Budgeting and banking will be included in the topic, and we will be able to make practical links to our Enterprise topic. Strategies for addition and subtraction and for problem solving will also form part of our Numeracy work.

Literacy: Our class novel this term will be Flat Stanley. Working in groups, we will be reading books from the Big Cat reading scheme and using Active Literacy strategies to help with comprehension. In Writing, we will be developing our skills in persuasive writing, linked to our Enterprise, and in writing recounts.

**Health and Wellbeing:** In Health and Wellbeing, the children will be exploring their own skills and talents; how everyone is unique and special and how we can use our talents to benefit our friends and community. Our PE lessons will be both outdoors and indoors, focusing on ball skills and gymnastics.

Interdisciplinary Learning: Our Christmas Enterprise will provide the context for lots of different learning activities, including Art, Writing, Technology, Maths and Listening and Talking.
